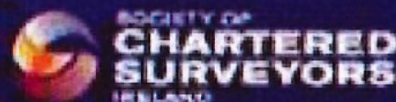

History of Kilmacud Community Mens Shed

The first meeting of the Shed was in Glenalbyn House function room on 16th January 2023 when 47 interested parties attended. Instigated by a small group of friends / Kilmacud Crokes members who believed there was possible local interest in such a community-based organization and were pleasantly surprised by the numbers turning up on day one.

Three years on in operation there are now over 90 members ranging in age from over 60 to 90 years. Approx 33% of the Shed members are active members of Kilmacud Crokes, and some are involved in running different aspects of the GAA club. The remainder of the membership have no connection with the GAA club

Activities

In the absence of having our own Shed Building the group have arranged the rental use of the function room in Glenalbyn from Kilmacud Glenalbyn Sports Club. KCMS meets every Monday from 9.30 to 1pm approx and provide fitness classes from 9.30 to 10.30 am to members with Tea / coffee and snacks available through out the whole time period.

At 11 am a formal meeting is convened which comprises of presentations / talks on specific subjects such as Age Action, Wills, and House Insulation and Solar Panels, History lectures, visits and discussions from personalities such as John Lonergan ex Prison Service, John O'Shea ex GOAL charity and various Chairpersons of DLRCC, presentations from members on such topics as Smyly Trust Services, Trips to Grand Canyon to name but a few. The rest of the meeting is a discussion on events being planned and organized by individual members with at least one every week for example trip to Dail Eireann, Stormont and European Commission in Brussels. Others include Kilmainham and Mountjoy Jail, Henrietta Street, Dublin Port, National Stud, Glasnevin Cemetery and many more.

Every Thursday morning members convene for a golf outing in Sandyford and in the evening another group meet socially in the Kilmac's bar in Glenalbyn House.

Community Supports shed members are involved in

Different groups of 10 plus members

- provide weekly support and maintain the grounds of Laura Lynn hospice for children and actively support and help organize annual events taking place in the hospice

- maintain the grounds of St Brigid's School and develop and maintain the horticultural elements of the school

- maintain and improve the grounds of Kilmacud parish church and sourced funding to develop a biodiversity plan for the grounds. Also actively support and help organize annual parish events like the Christmas Carol event.

- help maintain the grounds of Kilmacud Crokes including upgrading the boundary walls around the all-weather playing pitches.

Overall the establishment of the shed has been a great success and gone from strength to strength. Our ambition is to eventually have a stand-alone shed building of our own.

We have Junior and Senior Infants in one room, 1st and 2nd class in another, 3rd and 4th in the next one, and 5th and 6th in the final room. The school staff is made up of a teaching principal, three other classroom teachers, two support teachers, 1.5 additional need assistants, and one office administrator. We also have a long-standing PE teacher working with us, and generally about 70-80 families in our school community.

We pride ourselves on being involved in such a happy and friendly school! Due to our small numbers, all pupils are friendly with each other and there's a very relaxed and cheerful atmosphere throughout the building. While we follow the prescribed curriculum, we also strive to ensure learning activities are fun, useful and thought provoking! The redefined subjects areas being rolled out in primary schools from 2023 are: Languages, Well-Being, Arts Education, Social and Environmental Education, and Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) and we are very excited to explore them in the coming years!

St. Brigid's NS is very well resourced - we have recently invested in new maths and science equipment, PE equipment, and digital technologies, and our pupils are happily engaging well with these materials. We also have access to the fabulous community garden, located just outside our back door, and the children can observe the pond, plants and flowers, the hens, and vegetable growth throughout the year. We are incredibly grateful for the support from the parish as we access & enjoy the garden

Our pupils are a fantastic group, with a variety of personalities to keep our days interesting! Their good humour and smiley faces are the reason we teachers love our jobs, and we love how involved they are in their own learning! It's great to see them pop back for visits after moving on into secondary school!

Our Board of Management, PA and general parent community are a rock of support for the school, and no task is too small. Our BOM meet at least five times per year, and the PA help with fundraising, organising events, and finding information that will help our pupils and it's wonderful to see parents working so hard for our little school.

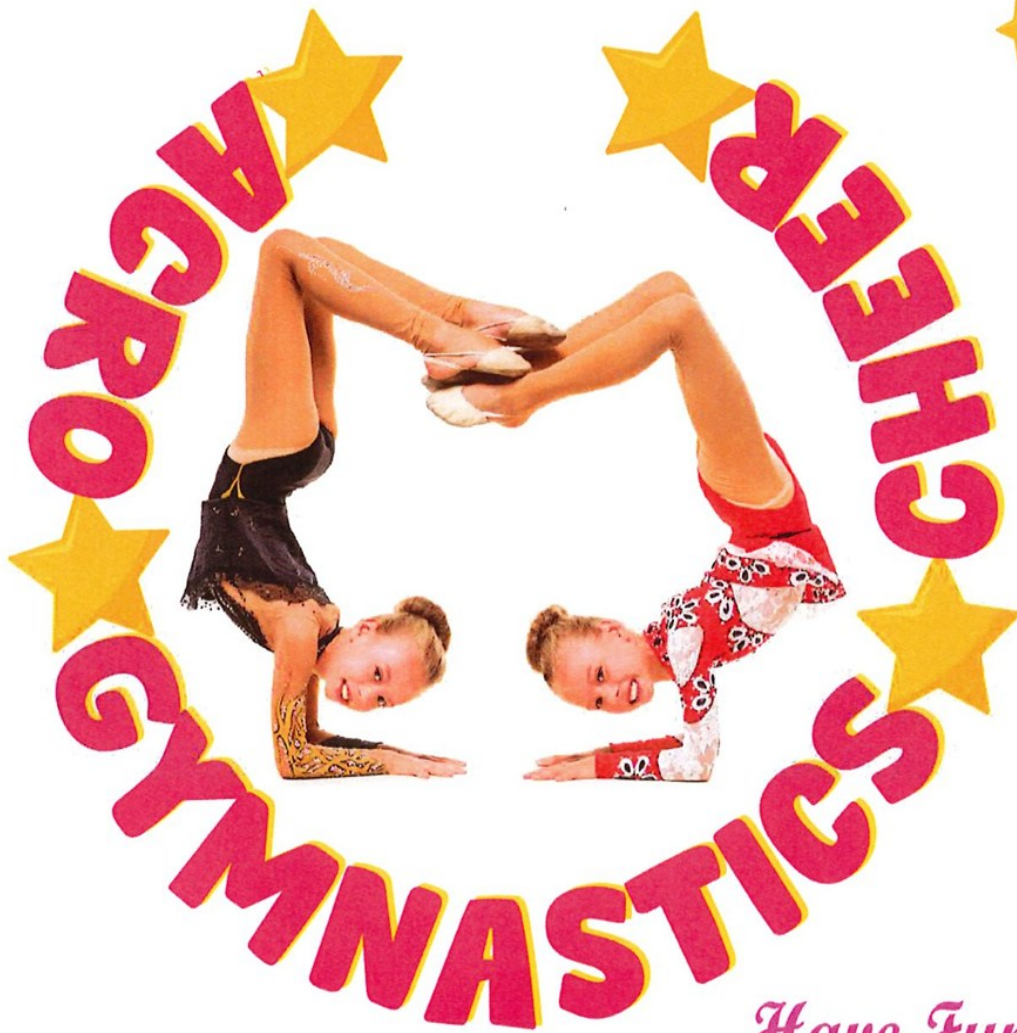

The Playschool is a place where children are inspired to develop an interest in learning for life, within a happy, creative and secure environment. Our aim is to create a stimulating learning environment ensuring each child reaches their full

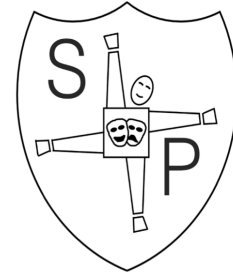

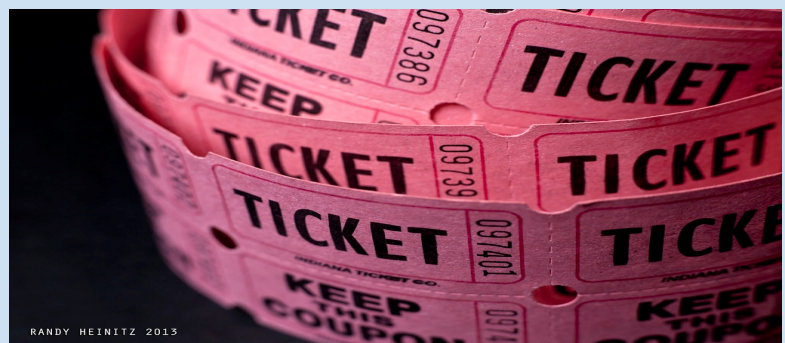

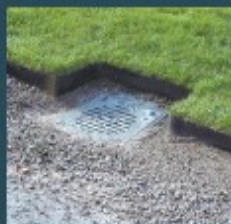
